ARRIVING TO GOTHENBURG

It is very easy to arrive to Gothenburg by different transports:

- Airport Landvetter Airport (approx. 30 km from competition area)
- Ferry from Fredrikshavn, Denmark Port of Gothenburg (approx. 2,5 km from competition area)
- Train Gothenburg Central Station (approx. 4 km from competition area)
- Car & bus possible as well!



ACCOMODATION

Detailed information regarding accommodation will be provided in the next Bulletin, the OC aims to offer 2 different price categories of accommodations – **Hotel** and **Hostel**. The price is expected to be between **40 EUR** per night up to **100 EUR** per night.


The accommodations will be very close to the competition area, approx. 1-1,5 km. No transportation will be necessary between accommodation and competition area!



COMPETITION AREA

The competition area is not 100% decided, depending on amount participants. However, the Plan A is **Boulecenter Majvallen** which is in the district Majorna not far away from central Gothenburg and very close to both **Port of Gothenburg** and **Train Station of Gothenburg**. The area also offers a rich culture of restaurants as well as nature, the famous **Slottskogen** is located side by side to the competition area.









COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- NBDPC25 will follow FIPJP official regulation: Official_Rules_Petanque-En (fipjp.org) + additional rules from NBDSF and NBDPC25 Bulletins
- Each countries can participate with a maximum of 6 men and 6 women
- Competition formats will be double (2 men / 2 women per team), mixed double (1 men & 1 women per team) and triple (3 persons per team)
- Tournament format will be Timed


COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- As per NBDSF decision ICSD number is not required of the athletes, national approved audiogram is accepted.
- All federations is responsible to ensure that every athletes is eligible for participating in Deaf Championship as per ICSD regulation of 55 dB or higher hearing loss on both ears.
- Hearing aids, Cochlear Implant etc. is strictly prohibited in competition areas.




ENTRIES + FEE

- Preliminary Entry will decide whether NBDPC25 can be completed or not. A minimum of 3 countries is required from both Nordic and Baltic.
- In Final Entry every participating countries must fill the correct amount of athletes and officials.
 Invoices will be created after Final Entry to be paid by the federations.
- In Name Registration each countries will fill the athletes + officials names as welll as photos.



ENTRIES + FEE

- The entry fee will be 25 EUR per person + discipline (i.e. double, mixeddouble + triple)
- The Entry Fee will be added to the invoice after Final Entry.
